Shift and CAPS

Some keyboards use the DVORAK system, named after its inventor Dr. August Dvorak. It is also known as the Simplified Keyboard, or DSK (Dvorak Simplified Keyboard). Some people think that this keyboard layout uses less finger motion when typing, so there are less errors.

Trace over the keyboard characters which are shown as they would appear when the SHIFT key is pressed. Use a dry erase crayon or dry erase marker. Sharpie Medium Point Permanent markers can also be used; wipe the board clean with a paper towel and rubbing alcohol.
